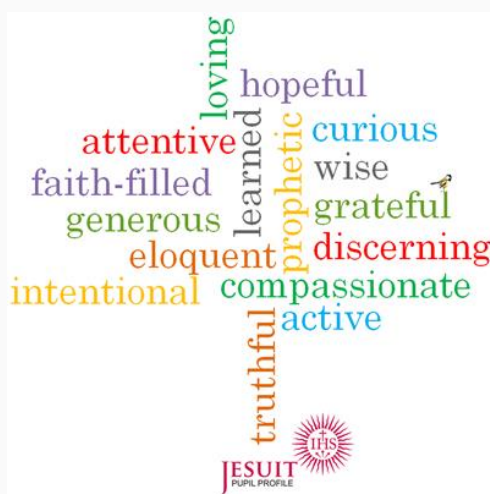


## Statement of Values and Ethos
