As most of you are already aware, the school experienced a break in over the weekend. Some ICT equipment was taken and damage was caused to a number of classroom windows. We are working with the local police and Diocese to rectify this issue as swiftly as possible. Both have been excellent in supporting our school community and we thank them for this. Approximately 20 iPads and 2 laptops were stolen - we can assure you that the laptops were password protected and encrypted, plus the iPads did not contain any sensitive information. Although this has a huge impact upon teaching and learning, we are working tirelessly to ensure that pupils are not disadvantaged.

The Safe Car Wash App

This app can be downloaded for free on Apple and Android devices. It has been created as part of a national campaign headed by the Catholic Church and Church of England, aiming to eradicate modern slavery in hand car washes. The app helps drivers to spot the possible signs of slavery, including whether workers have access to suitable clothing, such as gloves and boots.
