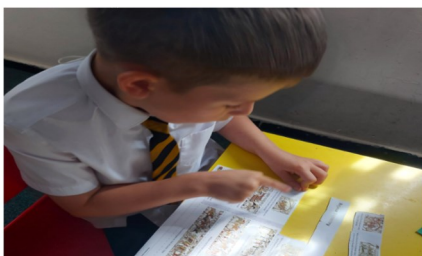

We would also like to say a huge thank you to year 2 for all their hard work this week for their Key Stage 1 SATs we are so proud of how hard you have all worked.



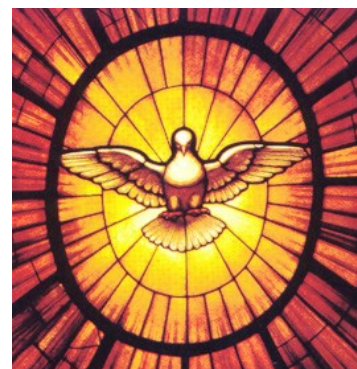
## This Week's Gospel— John 14:23-29

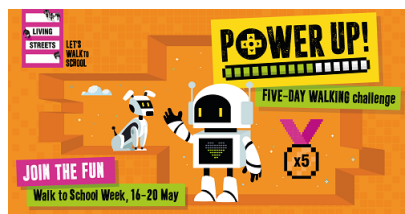

## Safeguarding Tip of the Week

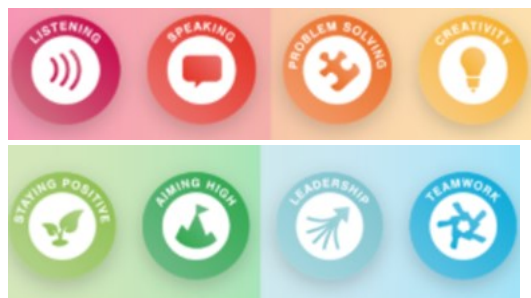
